Harvest Valuation Process

- Receive and store daily trade prices/market data
- Classify into discrete market sectors to be used in valuation process
- Check each item against vast database of traded securities
- Use documented trading in exact asset if passes Q/A
- Determine best model for those without trading or with trading that does not pass Q/A tests
- Apply and document highest level inputs/adjustments available (also used in leveling)
- Help client with follow-up and documentation
- Make pricing inputs available on every Harvest price



Harvest Quality Control

- <u>Pre-approval</u> Harvest obtains auditor approval before performing any work as a company specialist
- <u>Pre-planning</u> Objectives, scope, deliverable, timing
- <u>Independence</u> Harvest manufactures, documents, and supports all Harvest prices using market data (not a reseller)
- <u>Transparency</u> all inputs are made available to the client
